


# IS IT RIGHT FOR ME?

## IF YOU HAVE HEART FAILURE SYMPTOMS, ATRIAL SHUNTING MAY BE RIGHT FOR YOU.

Atrial shunting is a novel therapy specifically designed to reduce heart failure symptoms associated with high pressures in the heart and lungs. If you have been diagnosed with heart failure and continue to experience symptoms even when taking medications to alleviate them, the first step is to talk with your doctor about these symptoms.
